COURSE DESCRIPTION AND MAPS	<p>Approximately 2,000m of ascending, 4,000m of descending, and 44 Km approximate distance</p> <p>Approximate total GC time: 70mins+</p> <p>Approximate amount of climbing: One mechanical uplift to the start of Liaison Stage 1 and 5. All Liaison Stages are to be pedalled.</p> <p>Terrain Type: Tight and technical forested singletrack, wet roots and rocks, rain ruts, and some stream crossing.</p> <p>Course maps will be posted 17 Aug 2017, on our Facebook page.</p>

WATER STATIONS	<p>Water stations will be located at the top of various Liaison Stages, and elsewhere around the course where it is felt to be beneficial. These will be marked on a map at the Race Office.</p>
TECH SUPPORT	<p>Team / personal mechanics cannot fix rider's bikes during the race day. The riders must be ready to look after themselves out there. There will be neutral mechanics (by Buu Bike) on hand and some spares that can be purchased if they are stuck (like inner tubes). All riders should bring their own specific spare parts, e.g. dropout hangers, bearing etc.</p>
