COURSE DESCRIPTION AND MAPS	<p>Approximately 500m of climbing, and 20 Km approximate distance Approximate total GC time: 25mins+ Approximate amount of climbing: One mechanical uplift to the start of Liaison Stage 1. All Liaison Stages are to be pedalled. Terrain Type: Tight and technical forested singletrack, hard packed dirt and rocks with some stream crossing.</p> <p>Course map is posted on our Facebook page.</p>	
SEEDING and RACE ORDER	<p>Seeding order will be posted after 1800 on Sat 25 Nov. Highest ranking will be allocated to the first wave start, lowest ranking will be in the last wave start.</p>	
START LISTS	<p>All riders will have start intervals of 60 seconds.</p>	
RESULT	<p>End of day results posted in race office, Khao E-to.</p>	
CLAIMS/PROTEST	<p>All protests should be addressed to the Event Race Office in person, Khao E-to, within 15 minutes of provisional results posted. All protests must accompany a deposit amount of 2000 baht, protester will only get the deposit back if the protesting result turn in favour of the protesters. Race Director: Nawaphansa Yugala</p>	
PARTIES/SOCIAL	<p>Sunday lunch serve from 1100-1600 at the TES festival ground.</p>	
RACE RULE	<p>Please refer to the the Rule Book.</p>	
WATER STATIONS	<p>Feed stations will be located at the top of Liaison Stages 1 and 2, and along the Liaison 3 at the TES Festival Ground. These will be marked on a map at the Race Office.</p>	
TECH SUPPORT	<p>Team / personal mechanics cannot fix rider's bikes during the race day. The riders must be ready to look after themselves out there. There will be shops which may be carrying some spares parts that can be purchased if they are stuck (like inner tubes). All riders should bring their own specific spare parts, e.g. dropout hangers, bearing etc.</p>

We recommend that you download a grid reference/gps app to your phone and carry a map to make locating you easier and faster.</p>
