Letter from Thailand Enduro Series

Hello racers,

Welcome to the last round of the Thailand Enduro Series 2016. This is the round that will dictate the overall ranking of the 6 categories, to see who would be dominating and becoming the fastest en-duro riders in the Thailand Enduro Series 2016!

Lam Ta Khong, Hydropower Plant has been kind enough to let us built the trails in their area for the race and beyond, which mean that the new trails will be accessible as public trails for all mountain bikers! There are 3 freshly cut trails, 2 in the north and 1 in the south. Together with the old trail in the south side formed 5 spacial stages.

On Saturday, the qualification run will start at 1530 please be back at the event ground on time. The qualification result will set the seeding order on Sunday. Those who can not make it on Saturday will be set towards the back waves.

On Sunday, you will be riding 5 Spacial Stages and 4 Liaison Stages. You will be riding in a very wide range of trail difficulties in the Spacial Stages. Some will be easy and flowy, some will be pedal-ly, and some will be technical. The condition is very dry at the moment the ground is loose and rocky with some hard pack dirt. This condition will give riders with smooth riding style an advantage because the ground will bite back at you if charging hard and fast.

Again, we have made it easy for international racers and have made fully pampered packages available, all you need to do is to arrive at the airport. If you need to the book package please do so as soon as possible.

PARTIES / SOCIAL	On Sunday after the race, a late lunch for racers will be served at 1300-1600 at the festival venue.

WATER STATIONS	Feed station will be located on LS1, LS2, and LS3. These will be marked on a map at the Race Office.
TECH SUPPORT	Team / personal mechanics cannot fix rider's bikes during the race day. The riders must be ready to look after themselves during the race and should carry adequate tools and spare parts with them. There will be bike fixing station (supported by Sport Bicycle) at the Festival Venue and some spares that can be purchased if they are stuck (like inner tubes). All riders should bring their own specific spare parts, e.g. dropout hangers, bearing etc.
